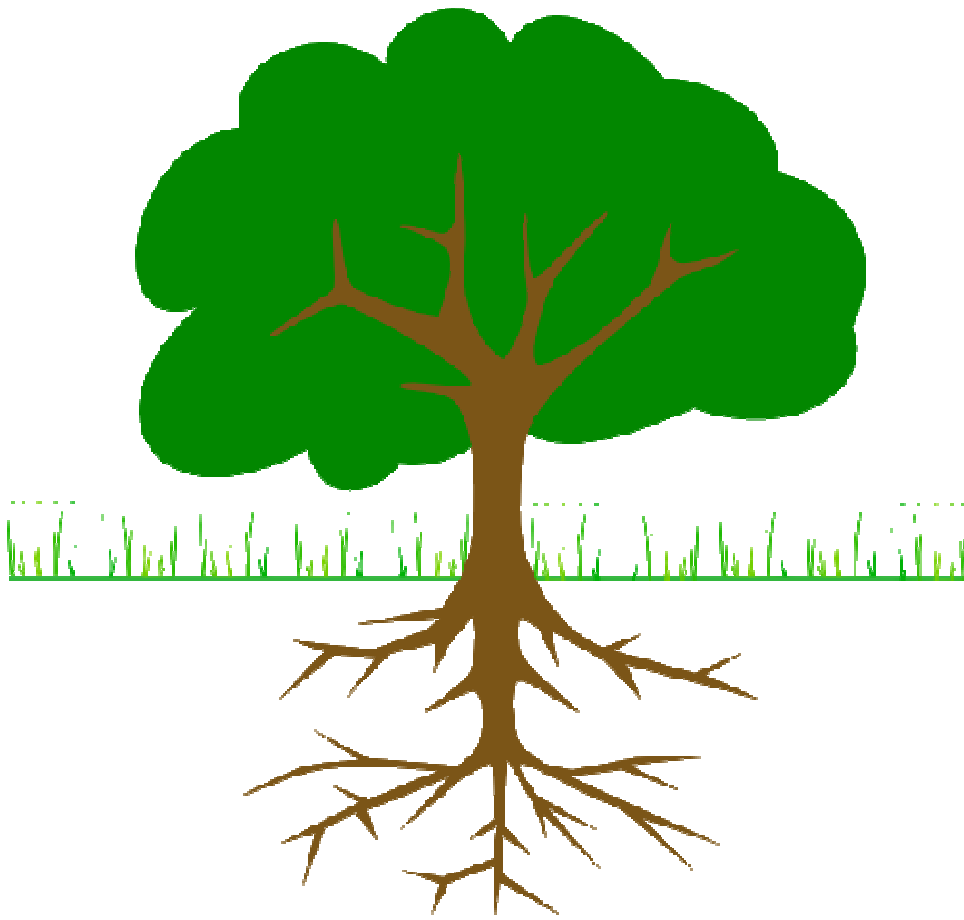

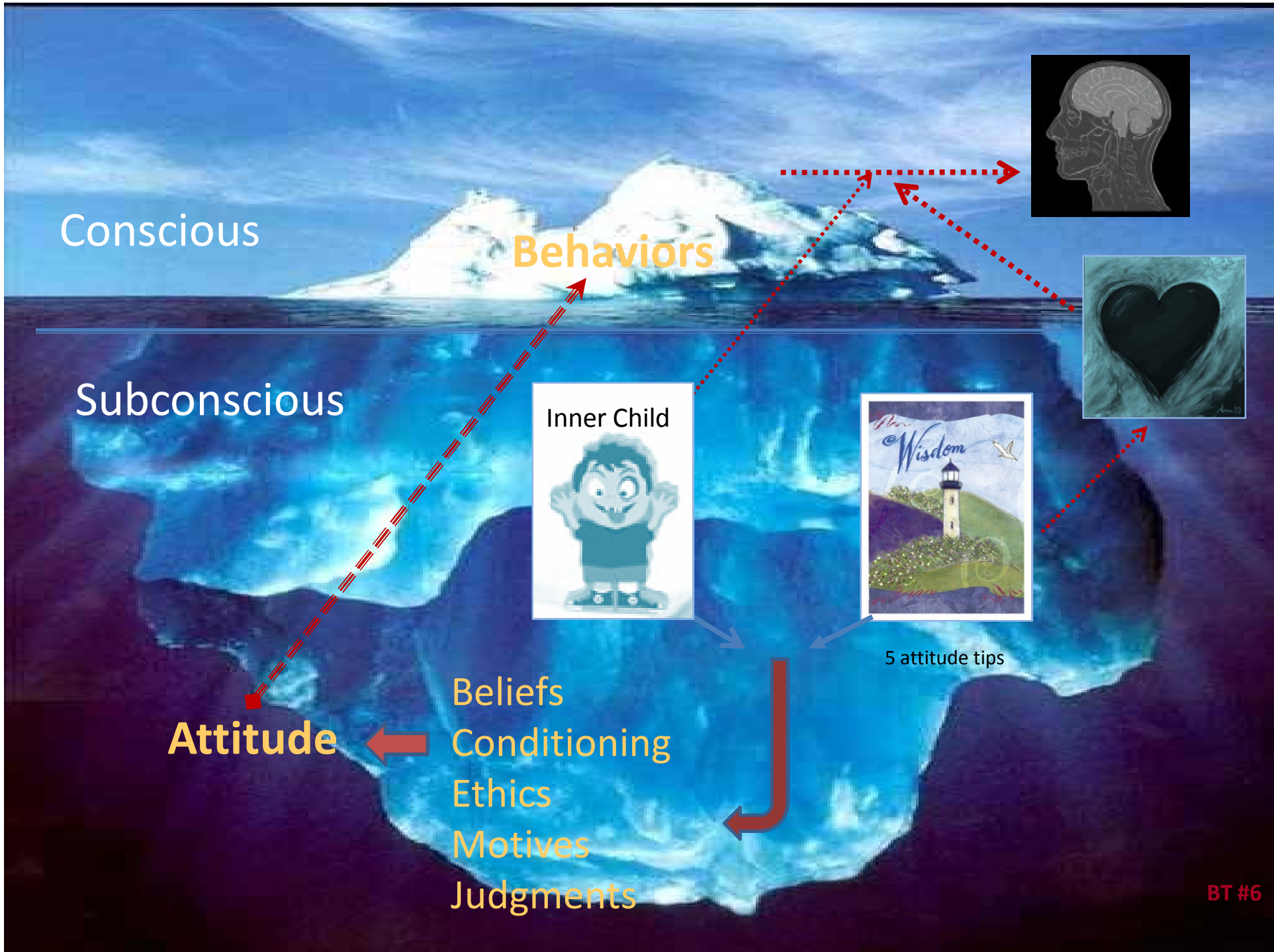


To change the outside, the fruit or the flower.....

## On thinking lofty thoughts

“Nurture your mind with **great thoughts**, for you will never go any higher than you think” – Benjamin Disraeli

Though no one can go back and make a brand new start, anyone can start afresh and **create a brand new ending**.

If you **work with the end in mind**, you will surely take yourself to that end.

“Nothing is, unless our thinking makes it so” – William Shakespeare

“Those who think they have no time for bodily exercise will sooner or later have to find time for illness” – Edward Stanley

## Chase away the inner saboteur

Redo your self talk

**Begin each task with the end in mind** – Steven Covey advise

**Always maintain a clean focus** – one thing, and only one thing at a time.

Think as though you are chasing rabbits. You can only catch one at a time, and only if you really, really try. Same is true of life.

Successful people **persist with their goals** from day to day.

Successful people got that way by **being happy**, snapping out of a funk state quickly, **cultivating variety** in their life, and blurring the boundary between work and play. “All work and no play makes Jack a dullard”

## Role of Values in our Life

Values are the bedrock upon which we build our lives

**They strengthen us**, give us instant reactions to observations

Those who are unclear about their values have a hard time making decisions.

In fact, “When your values are clear, your choices become easy” – Chani Pangali

**Write down your values, prioritize them**, and read stories that exemplify your values, as the stories will show you what is possible when your values are clear. e.g. Beowulf exemplifies courage and the hero path, Cinderella exemplifies acceptance, etc.

**Talk about your values** to your family to keep them in the forefront of your daily life, e.g. “We, Smiths, never take advantage of the weak. Let me tell you a story about my grandfather who was ....”

# Wisdom

Do not see an **intention** behind every mistake – many actions just are, they bring neither positive nor negative implications for you.

Do not be **swayed by every opinion** that comes your way – your own or others – reach for a deeper meaning

Follow the **sage advise**: “Leave each person that you meet *elevated*”

Opposite values are **complementary** – meaning **opposite sides of the same coin**

**Accept** people and situations as they are

**Present moment is inevitable** – do not fight the rain, the traffic, crowded trains, etc.

➔ 'What IS, is. When you are in the IS, you are at Ease. When you are not in the IS, you are in Disease'

1. Trade *Short-Term Focus* for LONG-TERM Focus

2. Instead of bemoaning circumstance embrace *PURPOSE*

3. Seek to be in *SERVICE* rather than focus on *self*.

4. See *OPPORTUNITIES* instead of *Problems*

5. Instead of wanting *Control* embrace *AGILITY (Flexibility)*

6. *LISTEN* more, *talk less* – enroll others in your cause

7. Trade *doubt* for *TRUST* – BELIEVE IN YOUR INTUITION
